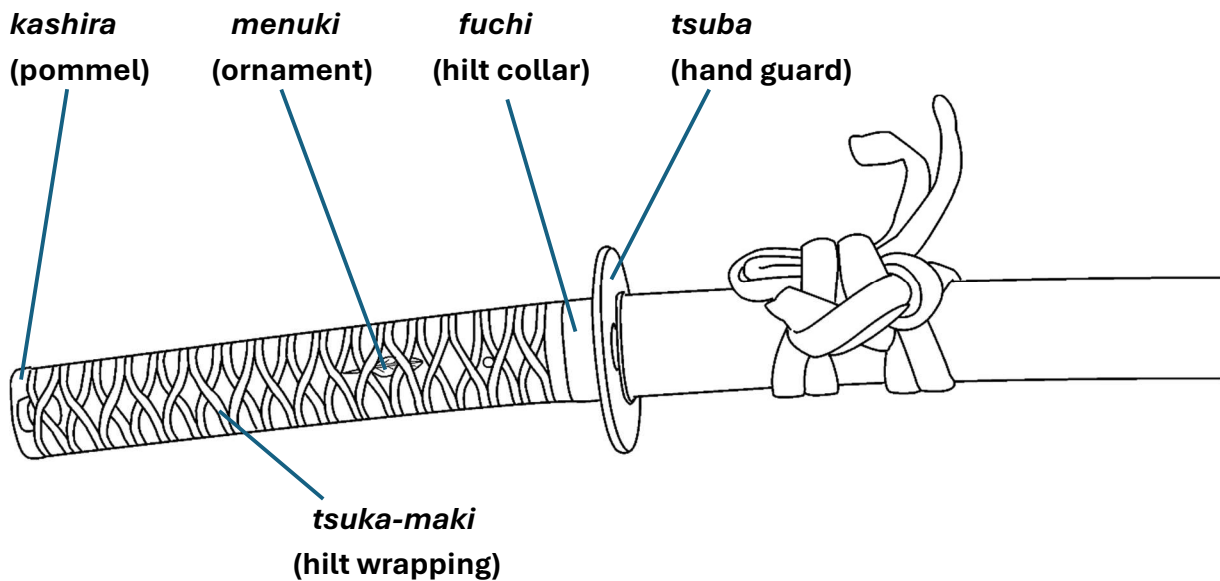
kani = crab
